### Pool Rules Reminder – Longmont

- With the pools now open at select communities, we'd like to take a moment to send a few reminders about the pool rules and regulations to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment of this amenity:
  - 1. USE OF THE POOL AREA IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
  - 2. Use of the pool is a privilege not a right. Management reserves the right to close the pool area or exclude any person from the pool area at any time, for any reason, without notice.
  - 3. Pool hours are from 10:00am 9:00pm. Hours subject to change at manager's discretion.
  - 4. No glass, alcoholic beverages, food, running, rough play, foul language or nudity is allowed in the pool area.
  - 5. The swimming pool is to be used only by residents and their invited guests. A resident must accompany their guests at all times.
  - 6. When using the swimming pool, swimming suits or trunks MUST be worn. Cut-off jeans and T-Shirts are not permitted.
  - 7. Keep noise at a low or moderate level at all times when in or around the pool as a courtesy to your neighbors. Be aware that some people work night shifts and need to sleep during the day.
  - 8. You are responsible for the behavior and conduct by anyone in your household, guests, and visitors inside the pool area.
  - 9. Friendly reminder the pool will be closed at times due to keeping the chlorine levels at appropriate levels.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

- How to Place an Emergency Work Order?
  - All after-hour Emergency Work Orders must be placed by dialing (303)443-0007. During office hours, you can place a work order by emailing <a href="maintenance@thistle.us">maintenance@thistle.us</a>, or by contacting your local Management staff.

#### How to Report a Concern or Complaint?

- For all non-urgent concerns or complaints (ie: Lease Violations), please contact your Property Manager directly via phone or email. Statements in writing are always most helpful here.
- For all non-urgent police matters, please contact the Non-Emergency Police Dispatch number at (303) 441-3333.
- For all life-threatening emergencies, please dial 911 BEFORE contacting Management.

#### Smoke-Free Policy:

• A friendly reminder that ALL Thistle properties are Smoke-Free Communities, including on patios and in common areas. This includes cigarettes, tobacco products, and marijuana.

#### Picking up after your Pets:

• Please ensure that you are picking up after your pets and animals, and disposing of the animal waste properly, and immediately.

#### Please Check your Emails for Communications from Thistle:

- If you are registered through RentCafe, you should be receiving email notifications from us. Please be sure to check your Spam/Junk folders, and please add your local Management Staff to your contacts list.
- Please encourage your neighbors to sign up as well the more resident involvement we have, the better!

#### **Frequently Asked Questions Continued:**

#### Rental Insurance:

- Not required, but highly recommended!
- Usually, you can bundle Rental Insurance with your Car Insurance for a small monthly charge.

#### Trash Disposal & Large Trash Items

- Please use care when disposing of trash, recycling, and compost materials.
- Large Item removals are charged back to Residents at \$41.00 per pick-up.

#### Quiet Hours:

- Thistle House Rules 10:00pm 6:00am
- Please be respectful to your neighbors excessive Noise at ANY time is not permitted.

#### Parking Policy:

- In most cases, parking is available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- In general, one car is permitted per household.
- Please reach out to your Property Manager with questions specific to your property.

#### Preventative Maintenance:

- To prolong the appliances and safety features within your apartment, we have begun conducting preventative maintenance at each property.
- Prior to any Preventative Maintenance visit, you will receive a Notice of Entry on your door. We appreciate your help and cooperation on this project!

#### Chargebacks:

- Per the Lease Contract, we are required to charge replacement items to residents beyond wear and tear (i.e.: in cases of damage, misuse, or neglect).
- We are always happy to talk through these charges with you, and we will only ever charge the exact cost of the item.
